2020 Connecticut National Nominations Candidates' Tournament

- Date & Time:** Saturday June 20: Denker (9-12) & Barber (6-8)
Sunday June 28: Rockefeller (K-5) & Girls
Round times: 9:30 A.M., 12:00 P.M., 2:30 P.M.
Followed by a blitz playoff in case of a tie for first place.

- TD:** IM Jan van de Mortel, US Chess Senior TD
- Format:** 3 Rounds Round Robin (all-play-all; pairing numbers randomly assigned by pairing software).
Time control: G/45;+5
Blitz playoff for 1st place; time control G/5;+3. Format depends on number of tied players; no Armageddon.
- Sections:** Denker (9-12), Barber (6-8), Rockefeller (K-5) and Haring (Girls K-12).
- Prizes:** Winner of each section will be the official state representative to the 2020 invitational National Tournaments of Champions which will probably be held August 8-9 on chess.com
\$100-50-25-25 in each section (upon completion of the event; cash prizes shared for all place ties). All prizes pending anti-cheating protocol by chess.com and TD.
- Entry price:** No entry fee. Qualification through the CT State Girls' (1/19/20), Scholastic State K-12 Championship (3/7/20), Northern (12/8/19) and Southern (1/26/20) NNGP legs, and by rating (March US Chess Rating Supplement).
