3 Sections: Grades 9-12, Grades 7-8, Grades K-6

5 Rounds Swiss, G/30;d5. Round 1 at 10 AM, all others ASAP. Award ceremony anticipated for 3:45 PM.

Prizes for Each Section:

Trophies to Top 3 and Top Team of 3 (minimum 2) in each section, and Top Kindergarten and Top First Grade in K-6. Commemorative medals to all.

Additional Prizes:

Top K-12 player receives \$300 CSCA stipend for National Girls' Invitational Tournament. 1st place finishers in each section receive free entry to the 2016 CT K-12 Scholastic Championships and 2017 CT Girls' Championship. If graduating high school in 2016, winner's school receives winner's entry. Top 3 K-6 & 7th Graders in Grades 7-8 Top 3 receive free entry to all local & regional UCONN K-8 events for the 2016-17 school year.

Additional Notes:

Ties with perfect 5-0 scores will be broken by G/5;d2 playoff. All other ties resolved by USCF tiebreak rules. Players not taking notation will surrender 5 minutes of their time to their opponent's clock.

Entry Fees: \$35 by 01-16-2016, \$45 by 01-21-2016, \$55 at site. Team registrations are \$5 less for teams of 4 or more registering **together**. Discount does not apply to on site entries. Teams designated by school only.

Entries: Payable to "Connecticut Chess Organization" and mail to Connecticut Chess Organization, P.O. Box 370233, West Hartford, CT 06137-0233. Onsite registration is 9 – 9:45 AM on 01-23-2016, cash only. Players not registered by 9:45 AM may be paired against each other or receive ½ point byes for round 1 at TD's discretion.

½ point byes are available in rounds 1 – 4, no last round byes.
