Trophies to Top 5 in each section, except: (1) Top 3 in Grade 1 and Kindergarten, (2) Top 5 9-12 and Top 5 7-8 in Grades 7-12 U-1100, and (3) No trophies in Barber Qualification. Trophies to Top 3 combined 9-12 teams, Top 3 combined 7-8 teams and Top 6 combined K-6 teams.
