One ½ point bye permitted in Rounds 1-4, must commit by end of registration.
- Sections:** 3 Sections: Open; U1800; U1200
- Prizes:** Open: \$300-\$200; \$100 to Top U2000. State Champion[1] plaque to Open winner.
U1800: \$200-\$100; \$100 to Top U1500. U1800 Champion trophy to winner.
U1200: Trophies to Top 3, Top U800, U600, U400, Unrated.
- Tie break:** For perfect (5-0) scores, a G/5/4 d2 playoff will determine the section winner;
USCF tie breaks determine seeding and color choice; does not affect money prizes.
