- Sections:** Seven Sections by Grade (limit on total participants):
Grades 9-12 (40), Grades 6-8 (52), 5th Grade (26), 4th Grade (26),
3rd Grade (26), 2nd Grade (26), and Grades K-1 (40)
- Prizes:** Trophies to all players scoring 3 points or more in each section.
K-1: Medals to all non-trophy winners in K-1.
Teams: Trophies to top 3 school teams in each combined section: K-1,
2-3, 4-5, 6-8 (Middle) & 9-12 (High).
You do not have to be from Connecticut to win one of these prizes.
- Connecticut Championship:* In addition to the above prizes, the top player from each grade, who resides in or attends school in Connecticut, will receive a plaque as Connecticut State Grade Champion.
