\$100-\$50 to Top 2 players in Reserve
Trophy to State Champion (Top CT player in Open) and Top 3 in Reserve.
Prizes based on final placement on USCF tie breaks, NOT USCF distribution rules.

- Non-Connecticut players welcome and fully prize eligible, except State Champion title/trophy and national nomination selection. Top placing Connecticut player in Open recognized as CT Champion, based on 2021 State Championship definition of “Connecticut player”.
- US Chess and CSCA definition of “Senior” is age 50+.
