Overall placement based on combined placement in all three events. Non-participating players in any event will be considered tied for last place. Cash prizes distributed via check by mail (PayPal distribution may be requested subject to PayPal fees), also see Note [4] tax requirements below.

(b) any player whose state is not designated "CT" with U.S. Chess, but who (i) resides or (ii) attends school in the state of Connecticut.

Event entrants pursuant to section (b) will provide proof of eligibility.
