NOTICE: Event Amended to Add K-3 Section and On Site Section Change Fee

Please note that the Elementary (K-6) Section has been amended to add a separate K-3 Section. The K-3 section is entitled “Primary” or “P” for registration purposes. The Primary has ten new individual placement trophies specific to that section. Grade Champion Plaques for grades K, 1, 2 and 3 are moved from the Elementary to the Primary. To win those grade plaques players would have to participate in the Primary and not the Elementary.

However, NNGP Candidate selection will remain unchanged. If you are a K-3 player interested in the NNGP selection for national nomination purposes, you will need to participate in the Elementary (K-6) section.

For team prizes, the Elementary and the Primary will be merged for the six already existing Elementary Team placements. A team can consist of Primary and Elementary players, or either.

I already registered. What do I need to do?

If you already registered for the event and you are a player in grades K through 3, you will be automatically re-registered for the Primary Section (K-3). You do not need to do anything. Likewise, any registrations received from K-3 players marked “E” will be automatically registered in the Primary Section.

However, if you prefer not to play in the Primary and wish remain in the Elementary (K-6), please e-mail Alexander Lumelsky at alexander.lumelsky@gmail.com to make the adjustment once your registration is confirmed received.

Section Changes Deadlines and Fees

There will be a fee of \$10 for “on site” section changes. To avoid the fee, section change requests must be received via e-mail to alexander.lumelsky@gmail.com by 5:00 PM Friday, February 10, 2017. All requests received thereafter will be considered and processed as “on site”.
