Sec/Rds/TC/Byes: 2 Sections: Open, U800; 4 Rounds SS, G/30 +10; USCF and New England rated
One ½ point bye for Rounds 1 through 3; 0 point byes any round.

Prizes: Trophy to Top 3 per section and any 3-1 or better result, not otherwise placing. Trophy to Top two U1200 in Open and two U500 in U800. Medals to non-placing participants (Team competition if 3 teams register.) Top Connecticut player in Open receives Connecticut State Champion trophy. See Note [1] below. First place ties resolved by Armageddon playoff immediately following Round 4.

Nationals: Connecticut Champion and runner up receive Nominee and Alternate status to the 2025 Haring Tournament of Champions. See [CSCA National Nominations Rules](#).
