½ point Rd 1 bye, if registering after 9 AM on 11/9. Reentry permitted before Round 2 into

U2200, U1700 and U1300. (See Champion restrictions under note [1] below.)

Grand Prix: 60 Enhanced CSCA Grand Prix Points.
