Strazdins captures city chess title

Arkadijs Strazdins, an employe of the Stanley Works, has won the New Britain double city round robin, a U.S. Chess Federation rated tournament, from a field of 20 entries for the 1971 season. His score was 36½ wins and 1½ losses.

The city chess champion drew a game with Robert W. Lane and lost to Peter Kloskowski, top player at Central Connecticut State College. Strazdins has defended his title for 19 years in a row.

Kloskowski captured second place with a score of 34.4. Lane, who led the tourney in the early stages, was third with a score of 33.5. Fourth was Daniel Lechowicz, finishing with a score of 31½-6½.

Other Results

Stanley J. Archacki was fifth, 27-11, followed by Tadeusz Szafranski, Donald Heslin, Paul Ligas, Edmund Valauskas, William Thomson, James Cowling, William Hall, Roman M. Kolodziej, Joseph Zisk, Alfred Goldstein, Stanley Liauksminas, Jonas Liudzius, Douglas Sandberg, Arthur Belliveau and John Aukshunas.

Awarded plaques made by artist William Thomson and other prizes, were: Strazdins, Kloskowski, Lane, Lechowicz, top student players Heslin and Ligas junior, Sandberg, and the tournament youngest player, John Aukshunas, who was playing his first tournament against much stronger players. He drew two games and won two games. The tournaments oldest player, Alfred Goldstein, who is more than 80 years old, played well and scored 14 wins. He was awarded a special prize for his excellent effort. Goldstein for many years was one of New Britain's best chess players and his records included a draw against Grandmaster Sammy Reshewski in a simultaneous exhibition.

The tournament director was Peter Kloskowski. The tourney was sponsored by Gen. Haller Post and New Britain Chess Club.

The sixth New Britain summer open chess tournament a U.S. Chess Federation rated, five round Swiss, will be held June 26 and 27 at Gen. Haller Post.
